Information and Application



History

The Mesa County EMS scholarship was created by the EMS Council to encourage conference attendance at the national level to allow networking with other EMS providers and instructors outside of our system.

Overview

The scholarship amount is \$1500.00

The scholarship will be awarded twice a year. Application deadline for conferences that occur January - June is December 1st of the year prior. Application deadline for conferences July – December is June 1st of the current year. Award notifications will go out 30 days after application deadline.

Detailed application instructions are included in this document. Please read through the entire document for important information about this scholarship program before beginning the application process.

This scholarship is to be used only for attendance at national EMS conferences such as EMS Today, EMS Expo and Gathering of Eagles.

Application Requirements and Instructions

The application form must be filled out in full

The application packet shall include a letter that states the following:

- The applicant is in good standing with the agency/employer
- The applicant is currently on Mesa County Protocol
- The agency/employer commits to covering any cost overage associated with the conference

The letter above must be signed by the applicant and the department chief or department head.

The applicant shall provide council with an essay that includes:

- The name of the conference they would like to attend
- How this particular conference will benefit the applicant, the agency and the county EMS system. *Please address in this section how it is beneficial to network with EMS providers around the nation*
- Demonstrate the financial need of the scholarship
- A requirement of this scholarship is to provide feedback to both the EMS Council and the Mesa County EMS system (via squad review) on what was learned. Include in your essay how you would present this material

Scoring

Your application and essay will be scored on the following criteria:

- Currently active in providing EMS in Mesa County
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated support of employer/agency
- Quality/Professionalism of essay
- Completed application with all documentation
