Ambulance Service Provider Information

1. Ambulance licensing is promulgated under the Mesa County EMS Resolution.
2. The Director will make application forms for Licenses and Permits available to prospective Licensees prior to **April 30th of each year**. Electronic copies of the forms will be emailed to all currently licensed agencies and hard copies may be picked up at the Mesa County EMS Coordinator's office at 215 Rice Street, Grand Junction.
3. The **deadline** for Ambulance License and Permit Renewal applications will be **May 31st** annually.
4. Licenses and Permits will expire on **June 30th** every year.
5. License and Permit fees will be prorated if necessary.
6. Ambulance Inspections will be scheduled within 30 days following receipt of the completed application form, all required documentation, and fees.
7. The application will be presented to the BOCC for their approval within 30 days after the Ambulance Inspection is complete.
8. All ASA providers will be notified should another agency petition for licensure in any provider's ASA. This notification will include the date of the public hearing where ambulance service licensing will be discussed.
